

Christmas Lights

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A PyroMyth pencil and paper game

For 2-3 players

It's nice to spruce up the Christmas tree with light even if your brothers and sisters are a little competitive about it. This year you'll show them how to do it right.

To play you will need to print out this sheet and have a different colored pencil or crayon for each player.

The board represents a Christmas tree the bulbs on it and the wires that join them.

Play starts with the youngest player. On their turn a player will do one of two things.

1. Color in any bulb not already part of a string of lights. (This is the only option on your first turn)
2. Continue a string of lights. This is done by coloring in a wire from a bulb of your color to another unclaimed bulb coloring it in. You may not cross a wire of another color. You may continue from either end of the string as long as the string does not fork.

Continue until there are no more bulbs to be claimed. Then the tree is scored.

One point for each bulb

One point for each wire

There are 6 levels on the tree from the lowest level with 6 lights to the top with only one. You get a bonus point for every level that you have the most lights on.
